ENVISIONING AN ARTS CENTER ON THE HISTORIC HIGH BRIDGE

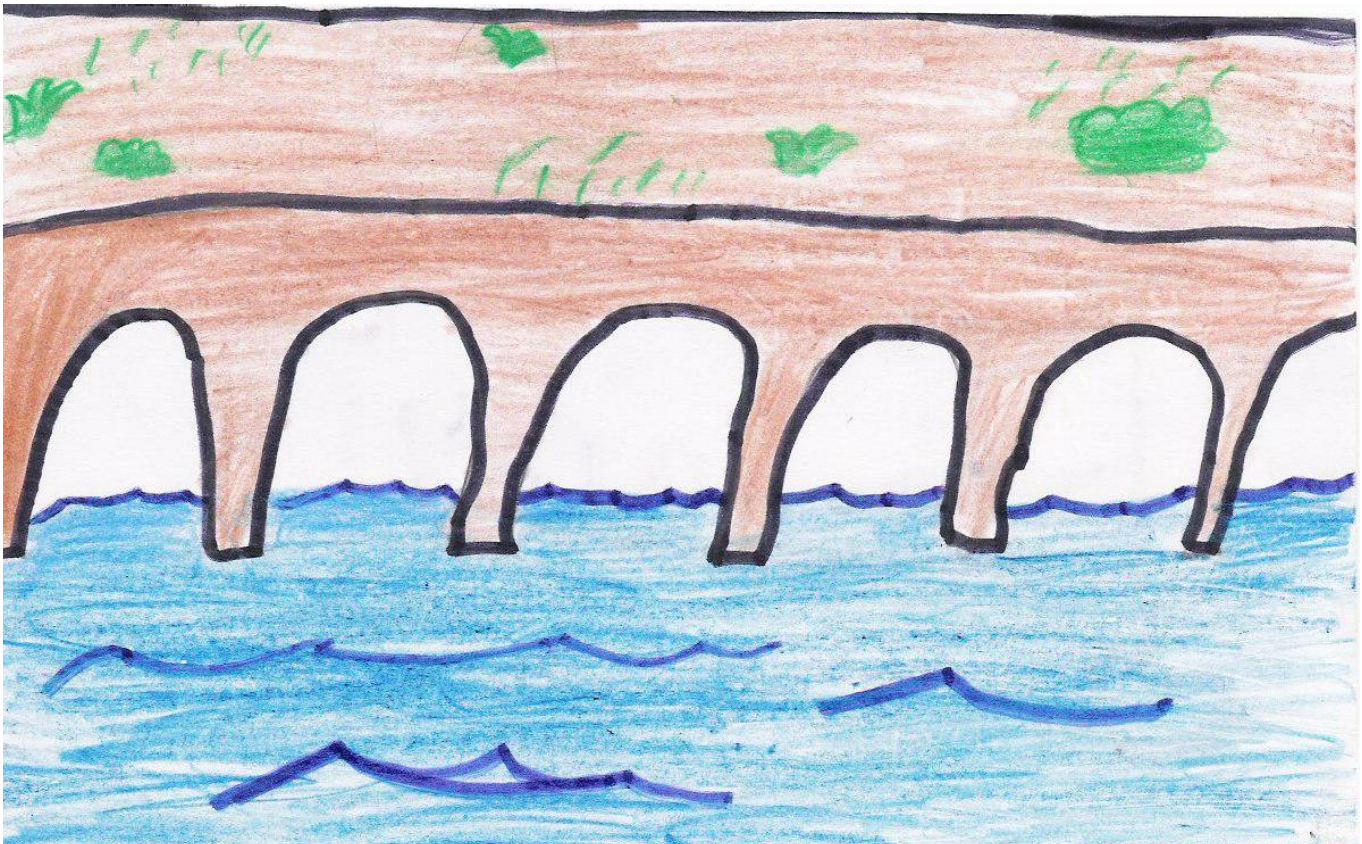
